Remember:

- **Clearly label or stamp all items with your child’s full name. Label Daddy** is a company that we have partnered with and offers printed name tapes for your convenience. You can order them at www.labeldaddy.com, and make sure you put in the code COLEMAN at checkout. Clothing can also be marked with a permanent marker. Every effort is made to reunite campers with their belongings before they leave camp. However, unmarked and unclaimed items will be donated to a local charity.
- Do not send expensive or “special” items to camp, as they are often lost or ruined.
- Please do not send hot pots, irons, items of potential hazard, and excessive amounts of shaving cream, water balloons, water guns, or silly string.
- Please do not send an electric fan.
- There is limited space in the cabins to store belongings.

Please note: while the number of items may seem like a lot since we do laundry during the session, campers wear multiple outfits each day. For example, a camper may wear sport shorts during the day for activities but then change into regular jean shorts for dinner and the evening program after shower time.
